





Main School Uniform


- ♥ Navy blue blazer with school badge (available from Hewitts)
- ♥ Optional navy-blue V-necked pullover with school badge (in House colours available from Hewitts))
- ♥ Navy blue A Line skirt with inverted pleat; available from Hewitts)
- in 18/22 inch length. SKIRT LENGTHS MUST BE NO MORE THAN 15CM ABOVE THE KNEE. NO OTHER SKIRTS SHOULD BE WORN
- Tailored school trousers in grey, charcoal, or black
- **Variable** Leggings, tight fitted and ankle length trousers are not permitted
- Flain white buttoned shirt with collar (both long and short sleeved shirts are permitted)
- House coloured tie (available to purchase via Wisepay)
- Flain white, navy or black socks
- Plain black or nude coloured tights (patterned tights are not permitted). Socks and tights should not be worn together
- Socks should not be worn above the knee

Footwear

- Flain black smart leather or leather-look shoes that are polishable.
- W No logo (due the nature of the Kickers' logo, Kickers are permitted).

 Shoes must be flat no platforms, boots, sling-backs, open-toe shoes or canvas shoes are allowed.
- To high boots or boots above the ankle line.

Getting to know your new school

Frequently asked questions?

Question	Answer
When will my child be set in their subjects?	Year 7 are only set in English and Maths. This happens by October half term.
What happens if my child is late?	He or she will be greeted by SLT as they enter the school, if late they directed to a holding room. If late after morning registration they should sign in a student services and then go straight to their lesson
How can my child contact me during the day?	Students must not use their mobile phones during the school day, they can go to student services to contact home
How much home learning will they get?	Year 7 students receive an average of one hour per evening. Tasks will be set on Satchel:one
What are the facilities for food and drink	Year 7 students can either bring in packed lunch or buy food from the canteen. The school operates a cashless system called Wisepay. Please make sure their account is topped up.

Please note it can take a few days to get our canteen cashless system up and running. Therefore, we suggest that your child brings in money to pay for snacks/lunch for the 1st week
