Years 7 - 11

Sparx Maths

As you will be aware, we are using Sparx to set home learning for Maths, English and Science.

Sparx Maths is due in for all classes every Monday. Even if it is not showing on Satchel it will still appear weekly on Sparx.

If students are unable to log in through the Microsoft method you can choose the new Sparx user log in method as an alternative. Please be aware that teachers can see how long it takes students to complete their homework so we can usually tell if they are using AI. We would recommend that they see their teacher, or attend Sparx club which runs every Wednesday. Sparx Science is set every Tuesday for years 7-11 and is due in every Monday.

Years 7 – 9

Years 7 to 9 are required to complete their Sparx Reading home learning weekly and should achieve 300 Sparx Reader Points each week for their home learning to be fully complete. Class teachers will set the deadline for this and it should also be on Satchel for them to check too. Please bear in mind that if students rush through the comprehension questions they will achieve fewer points, accuracy is the most important thing, so they should take their time to ensure they earn the highest amount of points.
