Year 10 Tracking 3

You will shortly be receiving access to the tracking for Year 10 via the Arbor app. This will be found under the "Report Card" section under Student Profile. The report will consist of the following:

Final Target Grade

This grade is based on CAT4 testing results and gives an indication of how students might perform in their GCSE subjects.

Exam Grade

Students sat an exam this term. The results of these exams are listed as a grade.

Predicted Grade

This grade is a teacher estimated grade based on student performance both in lessons, home learning and exam performance.

Attitude to learning

Grades for classwork, behaviour and home learning will be graded as before with E – Excellent, G – Good, R – Requires improvement and U – Unacceptable.

Behaviour points

This is an aggregated score consisting of the positive points combined with the negative points received.

Lates

This is the number of times this term a student has been late to AM registration (this does not include lates to individual lessons although this is available on request).

Comment

This is a new feature we are trialling with Year 10. The idea is that this provides students and parents with more detailed information on what students have been studying, how well students have accessed their learning, and what students can do next to improve their results. There are individual comments per subject and a tutor comment.

Information from Drama

Please note that the exam grade is on the written paper with no practical marks involved. The predicted mark takes both the written and practical work into account.
